SEED SWAP

The UGPG will be having its first annual seed swap this off season.

What's a seed swap you ask?

The way a seed swap works is, that all the members that would like to, send in their seeds after they are dried. After you wash your seeds, dry them for 4-6 weeks to make sure that they are completely dried or else they could get moldy and rot. Then put your seeds in a zip lock baggy include a label stating which pumpkin they are from and the cross if known, i.e. 906 Tanner 2004 (963 Stucker 2002 x 845 Bobier 2000) If you have more than one fruit then be sure not to mix them up. Put the seeds in a padded envelope and send them to him Gordon Tanner at 1393 S 750 E KAYSVILLE UT 84037. We will then package the seeds in those little coin envelopes, divide them up and send them out to each grower. We have 34 members now so if you can include 2-3 seeds from each pumpkin so that everyone will get some. Gordon and Brent have promised seeds from each of their 2005 pumpkins to each member. If you know that you will be at one of the seminars then let Kevin, Ray or Gordon know and you can pick up your seed swap seeds there.
